











# A PROPOSED SOLUTION TO A MAJOR CHALLENGE



### PROJECT PRESENTATION

- Project title: Bridging Digital Divide Among the Youth in the City of Kigali
- Project submitter: City of Kigali
- Key partners: Rwanda Information Society Authority (RISA), Digital Opportunity Trust (DOT), Rwanda, Ministry of ICT and Innovation, Liquid Telecom and Broadband System Corporation (BSC), MYCULTURE, Rwanda TVET Board among others.
- Sector: Information Technology
- Key objectives:
  - 1. Increase access to digital technology by establishing ICT Centers in identified rural administrative sectors,
  - 2. Enhance access to digital skills to drive inclusion and participation in the digital economy and personal lifestyle,
  - 3. Contribute to building the ICT centers' capacity to achieve and maintain operational self-sufficiency.
- Current status: One ICT Centre set up as a pilot project and conducted training to 60 youth (70% male and 30% female) in ICT Literacy, Gender Equality, Entrepreneurship courses and 21 st Century skills with practical application to their businesses and more to be trained in the same fields. We have also identified 9 sites where other Centres will be set.
- Project timeline: 5y years from 2023 to 2027
- Alignement with national & international objectives: deliver on the National target of achieving 60% of digital literacy among Rwandans by 2024 as well as digital inclusion in global world.

# **IMPACTS OF OUR PROJECT**

- Digital literacy: over the next five years, the City of Kigali is targeting to directly increase access to digital literacy for at least 11,520 young people living in rural areas of the City through the establishment of 10 more ICT Centers. Expected co-benefits: creation of more productive jobs, improved service delivery, increased citizen participation in economic development.
- Sustainability impacts: we expected to have enhanced environmental protection by having paperless working conditions, which will lead to environmental conservation as well as reducing all kinds of pollution challenges all of which will lead to better living conditions.
- Mitigation benefits, our project will reduce loss of life as the living conditions will be favorable and even the fact that people will be earning from the skills gained, their standards of living will be improved, poverty will be alleviated and increase of their life expectance as well.
